Once you've set foot on the "Far-Away Isle," you'll want to return again and again! Sense the history as you walk along cobblestoned streets by gray-shingled cottages and restored nineteenth-century mansions. Once a prosperous whaling and shipping port of the 1800s, Nantucket is now a beautiful and charming place to visit.

This three-day, two-night tour features **The Nantucket Inn & Conference Center**: The island's tour-friendly resort features 100 comfortable guest rooms nestled among three landscaped courtyards and a short distance from historic downtown. The area offers countless opportunities for adventure, explore, shopping, and appreciation of nature's beauty!

- Entrance pass to **Historic Nantucket Properties**, a collection of 11 buildings throughout the town which are owned by the Nantucket Historical Association. Together, they portray how islanders lived and worked as Nantucket developed from a small farming community, to the center of America's whaling industry, and eventually an important summer resort
- Time to discover the shops and boutiques
