Day 2: Today enjoy breathtaking views as you experience the Walkway over the Hudson. This beautiful pedestrian bridge is one of the area's newest attractions. Later travel to Hyde Park to visit the Vanderbilt Mansion. The estate, inside and out, offers a great perspective of the wealth and excess of the Gilded Age and one of its most prominent families. Relive some of the most tumultuous times in American history with a stop at Franklin D. Roosevelt Presidential Library. Fresh from a multi-million dollar update enjoy this walk back in time spanning his four terms in office. Steps away on the Roosevelt estate view Eleanor Roosevelt's Val-Kill and gain an interesting perspective of this most influential first lady. This evening enjoy dinner at a popular local restaurant. (B,D)

Day 3: Savor breakfast at your hotel before traveling to the National Purple Heart Hall of Honor Museum. Here learn about the extraordinary sacrifices of America's servicemen and women who were killed or wounded by enemy action. Next tour West Point, the oldest military academy in the United States. See the Old Cadet Chapel, Trophy Point, Battle Monument, and the Plain. Walk the grounds of the massive campus that has produced some of our country's greatest generals and leaders from Ulysses S. Grant to Dwight D. Eisenhower. Enjoy lunch at the West Point Officers Club located right on the grounds of the Academy. Later we head home with fond memories of our Hudson River Valley vacation. (B,L)

- Deluxe hotel stay for two nights at this National Historic Landmark
- Tour and history of the hotel by a local historian
- Afternoon Tea each day in the Conservatory off the Great Hall
- Meals include two breakfasts as well as two four-course dinners in the Grand Dining Room featuring dancing and music provided by the Mount Washington Hotel's Orchestra
- Time for shopping in North Conway after a trip to Mount Washington Observatory Weather Discovery Center: We will speak to staff members on the Mountain, who will explain how they track the weather at the Observatory. It can be a very interesting difference: That time of year, it could be a blizzard on Mt. Washington and 60-plus degrees in the valley!

Our deluxe Yankee Line motorcoach transportation leaves from the American Legion Post 440 at 9 a.m. on May 9 – with a stop for coffee and muffins – and we will return at approximately 3 p.m. on May 11 (to beat that rush-hour traffic!). Please remember that you cannot leave your car overnight at the American Legion parking lot. Enjoy food, wine, music, and surprises at the former to benefit the latter! **The 24th Annual Waltham Food & Wine Festival** is being held on **Thursday, March 31**, 5:30-8:30 at the Westin. Over 30 Waltham restaurants will showcase their cuisine, complemented by fine wines and craft beers served by the sommeliers of Gordon's Liquors.

The event brings together music, culinary arts, local celebrities, and amazing innovations. And this year celebrates Waltham's rich bicycling history, with some delightful artifacts and surprises, old and new! Tickets are \$50 – **Club 50 members receive \$5 off** the ticket price.

If you haven't yet visited Waltham's Charles River Museum of Industry & Innovation, please do!
