**\*\*On a final note in lieu of the very busy Tall Ships sign-up day we most recently had, I thought it might be helpful to include a reminder of our Club 50 trip sign-up procedure! For every scheduled trip we will designate a date for when sign-up is open. This first day of sign-up is always notated on the reservation form. Beginning at 8:30am (or if there is an alternate time noted on the form) on the established first day we will start taking reservations for our trip passenger list. If you cannot make it down to the Main Office on sign up day, we do accept forms to be mailed in to us. If you drop off or mail in a form prior to the sign-up day, we will hold on to it and in the order of when we receive. However in an effort to keep the process fair, we will not add you to the passenger list until 12:00pm the day sign-up is open. Also as a reminder you are only allowed to sign-up one guest per member on all Club 50 trips. In rare circumstances if a trip is not full, we will allow members to bring more than one guest.\*\***
